

Course in Transport and Logistics Employment Pathway (22467VIC)

What is being offered?

A short (six week) accredited course that has been developed in conjunction with local businesses to provide a pathway into the Transport and Logistics industry for young people and school leavers. As an entry level Victorian Government qualification, this course is recognized nationally, and the content is made up of competencies that can be used to support other training qualifications.

Who is offering the course?

The first course will be run by Aust-link **starting on February 22, 2021.**

How will it work?

This course is a mix of workplace training and institution-based learning and will provide you with the basic skills to enable you to start working within a Transport and Logistics business. During the course you will have the opportunity to experience the industry first-hand by spending over two weeks in various local Transport and Logistics businesses.

What does the course provide in terms of Knowledge and Skills?

The *Course in Transport and Logistics Employment Pathway* ensures that students upon graduation of the course will be able to:

- Work safely within a Transport & Logistics business
- Understand workplace expectations, and the expectations of employees
- Have knowledge of both communication procedures and protocols
- Basic experience and understanding of how to care and maintain equipment that is used within a Transport and Logistics business
- Have an understanding of team communications – verbal and written
- Make basic workplace calculations
- Developed self-knowledge and the ability to self-manage within a workplace setting.

What will the units of competency cover?

The units of competency explored in the *Course in Transport and Logistics Employment Pathway* include:

- Investigating the local industry
- How to apply chain of responsibility legislation, regulations and workplace procedures
- How to follow work health and safety procedures

- How to inspect vehicles
- Using and maintaining minor mechanical equipment
- How to shift materials safely using manual handling methods

The following license units are also able to be undertaken during the course; depending on your age and any prior experience **one** of the units will be available

- Operating a forklift
- Operating an order picking fork-lift truck
- Driving a light rigid vehicle
- Driving a medium rigid vehicle

How do I apply?

Fill out the Expression of Interest (EOI) form.

Am I eligible for any training subsidy?

There are currently several training subsidies available to Victorian school leavers and young people. Please contact us directly to discuss your eligibility.

Do I need any special equipment or clothing?

There is no need to purchase special equipment or clothing for your institution-based learning, however when you are undertaking your work placements you will be required to wear enclosed shoes or boots, long pants and a long sleeve shirt.

High visibility vests and any other safety gear will be provided by the employer.

What about age?

This course is available to all Victorians who have left school within the past two years. You do not have to have completed year twelve.
